Tour 1 – Darwin's Footprints 3 nights/4 days...

Highlights include: Walk among giant tortoises at a private reserve and explore amazing lava tunnels and Los Gemelos; Kayaking and snorkelling at the Canal de Itabacal; Hike to Sierra Negra Volcano.

Tour 2 – Darwin's Footprints 4 nights/5 days...

Highlights include: Kayaking and snorkelling with sea lions, sharks, marine iguanas, sea turtle, rays, schools of fish; Walk among the giant Galapagos tortoises; Hike to the second largest cauldron of the World, amongst active fumaroles; Walk among iguanas and see white-tipped reef sharks.

Highlights include: Kayaking and snorkelling with sea lions, sharks, marine iguanas, sea turtles, rays, schools of fish; Walk among the giant Galapagos tortoises; Hike to the second largest cauldron of the world amongst active fumaroles; Walk among iguanas, and see white-tipped reef sharks; Tour to "Los Tuneles" one of the most spectacular places in Galapagos; Snorkelling at "Finados" between mangroves and lava, with sea turtles, sharks and sea horses.
